

HOW TO MAKE A KOKEDAMA HANGING GARDEN

STEP 1

MIX BONSAI SOIL
PEAT MOSS,
AND CLAY
INTO A BALL.



STEP 2:

DIG A HOLE;
TUCK PLANT
ROOTS INSIDE



STEP 3:
COVER WITH
SHEET
MOSS



STEP 4:
WRAP WITH
TWINE



STEP 5:
HANG IT
UP...



... AND MIST
WITH WATER

KOKEDAMA RECIPES:

You just need 4 things: Plant, Soil Mixture, Moss & Twine

Basic Soil Mixture

2 c. Bonsai Soil

2 c. Peat Moss

Water

Enhanced Soil Mixture

2 c. Bonsai Soil

2 c. Peat Moss

1 c. Clay or Worm Castings

Water

KOKEDAMA SUPPLIES:

Bonsai Soil (8 qt. bag) – City Peoples, Swanson's, Sky

Peat Moss (4 or 8 qt. bag) – Lowe's or any nursey

Clay (Excelerite Remineralizer & Micro-Organism Multiplier; 7.5 lbs.)
– Amazon

Worm Castings (Vermisterra; 10 lbs.) – Amazon or some nurseries

Preserved Sphagnum Sheet Moss (need to rehydrate) – Swanson's,
Sky, craft stores

Live Sphagnum (bagged) Moss – City People's

Twine (jute, waxed cording, fishing line) – craft, hardware and
garden stores
